

## TV Documentary Traces Evo Construction

The **South Group**'s 23-story **Evo** may look elegant and polished from the outside, but a television series debuting Sunday reveals the rugged, often dangerous construction process that brought the project to fruition. Filmed over a two-year period, the five one-hour episodes of "L.A. Hard Hats" on the **National Geographic Channel** follow construction from start to finish from the point of view of different tradesmen, including ironworkers, concrete crews, electricians and glaziers. "We take for granted that... you get the permits and the financing and then the building gets built," said **Tom Cody**, principal at the South Group. "Well it doesn't work that way. There's kind of a whole cast of heroes on the job site that are working under complicated and often dangerous circumstances every day to build skyscrapers." The show premieres Aug. 3 with back-to-back episodes at 9 and 10 p.m., then airs Monday nights beginning Aug. 4 at 10 p.m. More information is at [natgeotv.com](http://natgeotv.com).
